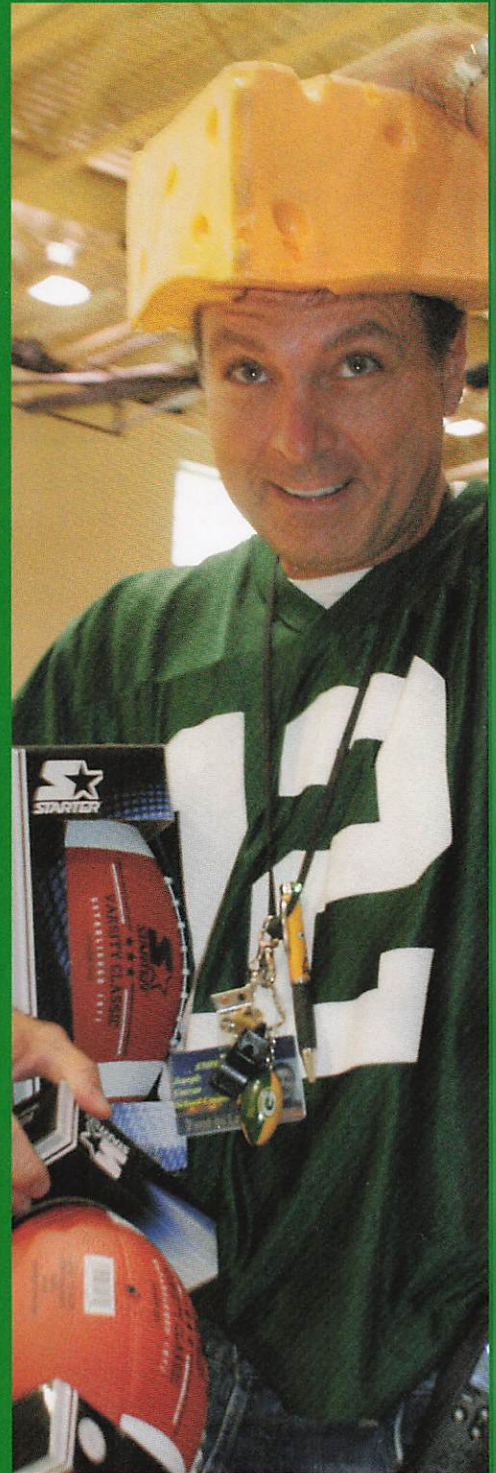

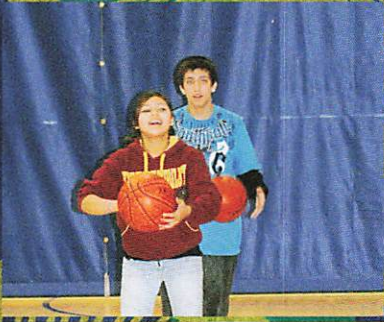
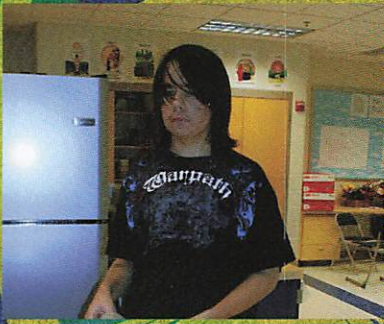
2010-2011 Dedication
