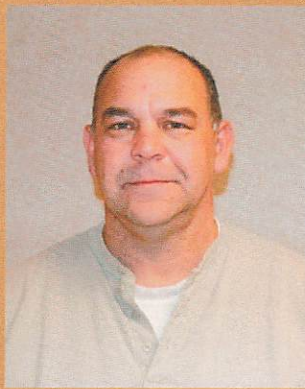
2012-2013 dedication

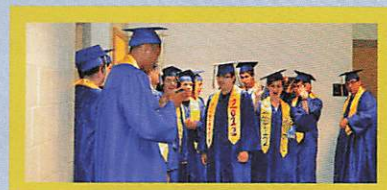
Prom 2012 was a smashing hit. The theme was "rave" and the colors were anything neon! Mr. Shawn provided the music for us.

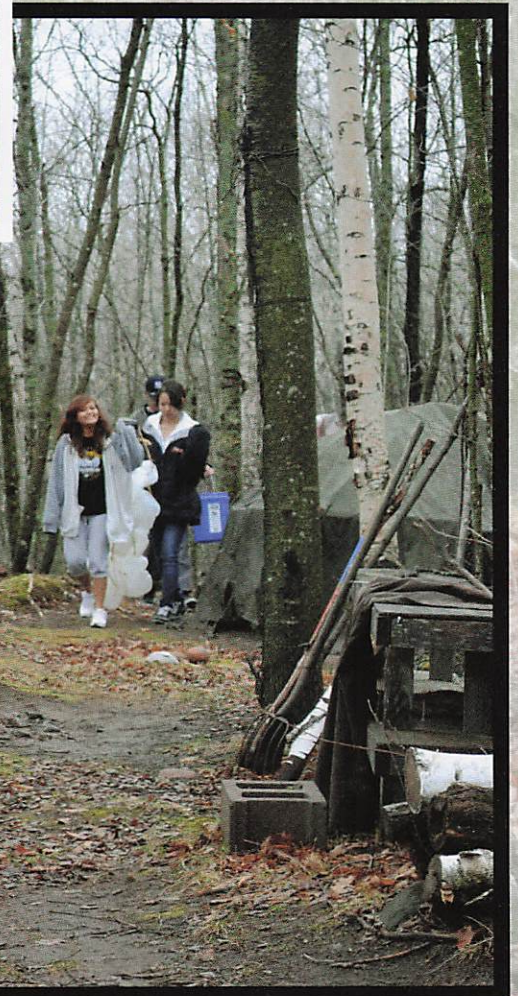
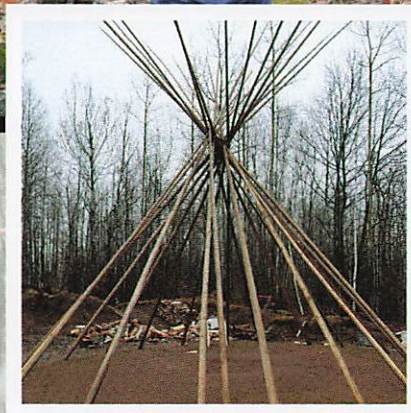


This year we went out to the Northrup's sugarbush and helped with the gathering of the sap.
